Re: Baseline Testing

As many of you are aware, we began our Covid-19 baseline testing per the mandate from the Pennsylvania Secretary of Health, Dr. Rachel Levine, this week which requires us to test all residents and team members.

Testing commenced this week and will continue each week until all residents and team members have been tested. As part of this testing, one team member, who works in an ancillary department and is not directly involved in resident care, tested positive for Covid-19.

Leading up to the test, the team member's involvement with residents and fellow team members was very limited due to the nature of the individual's role within the organization, and the team member had followed appropriate masking and social distancing protocols while at work and in their personal life. Because the team member has had no symptoms of Covid-19, and continues to have no symptoms, we plan to retest this individual early next week.

Currently the team member is not permitted to work, we will be following guidance from the Pennsylvania Department of Health to assist us with a return to work plan for them.

We will continue to follow the same infection control protocols already in place in order to keep our team and residents safe.

As has been our practice since the inception of this pandemic our goal is to keep the residents, families and team members informed and we will continue to keep you updated as we continue with the baseline testing.
