



ATTENTION ST. PAUL'S RESIDENTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS – The Villas, The Heritage, and The Ridgewood

8/5/2020 COVID-19 UPDATE – *please read this in its entirety.*

St. Paul's Senior Living Community, Greenville, PA, continues to adjust its action plan in response to information, recommendations and requirements shared by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA-DOH) and others. As you know, St. Paul's serves a fragile population and we have a responsibility to implement a plan of action to protect our population and our workforce. ***Please keep in mind that all of the steps we are taking are in the best interest of the health and safety of residents and staff.*** Also note, that our plan of action is subject to change as new information becomes available.

IMPORTANT UPDATE:

Early this evening we received notification from one of our team members at the Villas, who works in an ancillary department, that they have a pending positive COVID-19 test result. At this time they are waiting for written confirmation of the test results.

Therefore, according to the reopening guidance, it is with a heavy heart that we inform you that St. Paul's must temporarily suspend family visitation opportunities and barber and beauty services at the Villas effective immediately. We are in the process of communicating with the PA Department of Health and will follow through with the protocols set forth by PA DOH and CMS and will provide additional information to all once it becomes available.

At this point in time what we can share is that this team member's interaction with residents and other team members was extremely limited over the past two weeks and that they have indicated to us that they followed all recommended infection control policies while at work.
