IMPORTANT – 8/19/2021 COVID-19 UPDATE – *please read this in its entirety.*

St. Paul's Senior Living Community, Greenville, PA, continues to adjust its action plan in response to information, recommendations and requirements shared by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA-DOH) and the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS). As you know, St. Paul's serves a fragile population and we have a responsibility to implement a plan of action to protect our population and our workforce. ***Please keep in mind that all of the steps we are taking are in the best interest of the health and safety of residents and staff.*** Also note, that our plan of action is subject to change as new information becomes available.

We continue to perform covid-19 testing on all team members in accordance with guidelines provided to us by CMS, PA DOH and PA DHS. Team members who present with symptoms consistent with Covid-19 are taken off the schedule and advised to consult with their clinician. In addition, we are testing residents who present with symptoms consistent with Covid-19.

Yesterday, we completed our required testing on all residents and team members and are pleased to report that all tests are negative. Per regulations, we will be testing all residents and team members again next week.

Effective immediately, we can resume visitation. Please continue to follow the visiting guidelines in place as outlined below.

VISITATION

- VISITING HOURS are daily 9:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- We ask that you DO NOT visit if you are sick.
- Visitors are to screen before each visit using the Accushield screening kiosk located in the reception area. If you receive an alert at any time during your screening please see the receptionist. If the receptionist is away from the desk, please wait until you are assisted by a team member. DO NOT enter the building without a completed screening. You must display your screening tag on your person at all times while in the building.
- Visitors are NOT PERMITTED in the dining rooms. If you are joining your resident for a meal it must be consumed in his/her room/apartment.
- Common areas may be used for family gatherings but must be planned prior to the gathering with the receptionist. Visitors are not permitted in common areas when other residents are present.

OVER

- Visits are limited to three (3) visitors at one time.
- Masks must be worn at all times during visitation.
- Social distancing should be maintained.
- Please use proper hand hygiene before, during and after your visit.
- Children are permitted and count toward the total number of visitors permitted at one time.
- Pets are also permitted and must be on a leash at all times as appropriate. Pets must be vaccinated and vaccination records must be on file in our administration office.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we continue to navigate through this pandemic.
