



ATTENTION: VILLAS RESIDENTS, FAMILY MEMBERS AND TEAM MEMBERS

IMPORTANT – 4/9/2021 COVID-19 UPDATE – *please read this in its entirety.*

In accordance with shared recommendations for the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH) and others, we are required to notify you each time there is a change or development in our Covid-19 status, including new cases among residents and/or team members. We are also required to notify you if we admit a resident with a Covid-19 diagnosis even if they have met the criteria for discontinuation of transmission-based precautions.

Visitation remains suspended pending the results of another round of staff testing per the guidance from PADOH. We are working to accomplish this quickly and will update you as soon as possible. We are happy to report that the resident tests completed this week were all negative.

Also, we are required to notify you that one resident was admitted who has met criteria for discontinuation of transmission-based precautions. As such, we have updated our cumulative totals below.

Since November 2020, we have had a total of 55 residents and 78 team members at the Villas test positive for Covid-19. We have also had six third party health care workers who provide services to our residents test positive for Covid-19. Furthermore, we have admitted eleven residents who have tested positive and had met the criteria for discontinuation of transmission-based precautions upon admission and one resident from elsewhere on campus who tested positive.
