IMPORTANT – 9/20/2021 COVID-19 UPDATE – *please read this in its entirety.*

In accordance with shared recommendations for the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH) and others, we are required to notify you each time there is a change or development in our Covid-19 status, including new cases among residents and/or team members. We are also required to notify you if we admit a resident with a Covid-19 diagnosis even if they have met the criteria for discontinuation of transmission-based precautions.

We have been notified that one of our team members has tested positive for Covid-19. In this case, based on our contact tracing, no close contacts or higher-risk exposures as defined by CDC, CMS or PADOH guidance have been identified with any residents or staff.

We will continue to perform routine testing of team members as per PADOH and CMS guidance. In addition, any team members who present with symptoms consistent with Covid-19 are taken off the schedule and advised to consult with their clinician. Any resident(s) who present with symptoms consistent with Covid-19 are tested.

We'd also like to take this opportunity to remind all visitors – we would kindly ask that you please postpone visitation if you have any cold or respiratory symptoms or if you have been around anyone with cold or respiratory symptoms in the last 14 days regardless of your vaccination status. We ask this in an abundance of caution for our residents. Thank you!
